2. **Mayor's Comments**

NB Hall of Fame Inductee Nancy Morrison - Mayor Driscoll acknowledged and congratulated Nancy Morrison, a Quispamsis resident, who serves as the Athletic Director at Kennebecasis Valley High School. Nancy has been named as one of this year's inductees into the New Brunswick Sports Hall of Fame. She will be inducted on June 7th in St. Stephen. A gifted softball player in her youth, she

continued her involvement in the sport as an umpire, achieving international certification in 1998. She has officiated at five national events as umpire-in-chief, and she was selected as an umpire for the 2008 Olympics in Beijing. Nancy is also a nationally-certified basketball referee.

<u>First Responder – KV Superstore Store Manager - Matt Barnett –</u> Mayor Driscoll shared an email he received Mr. Brian Mackiel regarding a happy ending that happened at the KV Superstore on Feb. 14th and acknowledged local hero, Matt Barnett, store manager at the KV superstore.

Mayor Driscoll noted that the KV Superstore is not in Quispamsis but does support many activities within Quispamsis and the Valley and were the very quick to offer assistance during the December Ice Storm and Power Outage.

Mayor Driscoll read a portion of the email:

"When a longtime employee at Atlantic Superstore here in the Valley, collapsed on Friday, February 14, store manager Matt Barnett was summoned. Mr. Barnett quickly realized that his employee was in cardiac arrest and began CPR. He continued until paramedics arrived a short time later."

The employee was taken to the Saint John Regional Hospital where he was treated.

"If it wasn't for the quick action of Store Manager Mr. Barnett, we might not have such a happy ending".
