Overnight snow clearing set for Quispamsis

QUISPAMSIS – Residents in some areas of Quispamsis can expect to see and hear late-night snow clearing operations tonight.

The town's efforts will focus on Country View Estates, Kingsview Subdivision, Sherwood Park, and the Cedar Ridge, Donlyn and Peat Drive areas. The work has begun and will continue uninterrupted until at least 8 a.m. Saturday.

"We want to ensure our residents aren't alarmed if they see equipment on the street late tonight," said Gary Losier, the town's director of engineering and works. "We need to remove more snow before the next storm hits on Sunday."

Most of the work will be done by a large snow blower, which will help make the roads more passable. It's possible some snow may be blown back onto residential properties. Adults should ensure that children are not playing in snow banks near the road, and motorists should be cautious when the crews are in their neighbourhood.

"They won't be in one place for very long, so we hope that any inconvenience will be minimal," Losier added.
