Snow removal continues in Quispamsis

QUISPAMSIS – All streets in Quispamsis have been plowed after last night’s storm, but there’s more work to be done.

While every road in the town has received an initial plowing, most streets remain extremely narrow. With another storm in the offing for later this week, crews will be out pushing back snow to make it safer for vehicles and pedestrians. This will result in more snow accumulating at the end of driveways, most of which have already been cleared.

“We apologize for the inconvenience, but these are extraordinary circumstances,” said Gary Losier, the town’s director of engineering and works. “We hope our residents will be patient and understanding as our crews continue to do their work.”

Motorists are advised to exercise extreme caution, especially at intersections where visibility is reduced due to the huge mounds of snow, and when leaving their driveways.

A full complement of snow-removal crews will be dedicated to the clean-up for the next few days. They will begin on priority streets before making their way to the subdivisions.
