If you are a highly energetic motivated student that enjoys working outdoors and being part of a team, and are looking for a summer job, this could be your opportunity!

Responsibilities may include:

- Provide pool supervision and ensure safety of patrons at the pool
- Instruct and supervise swim program and classes
- Assist with program registrations
- Attend daily in-service training programs and weekly staff meetings when required
- Assist with general maintenance, cleaning and inspection of equipment, pool deck and green space areas, including picking up litter
- General maintenance of lifeguard office, washrooms, and public change rooms
- Shift work is required which includes evenings, weekends and holidays
- Perform other duties as required

All pool activities must meet the standards and follow the guidelines set out by the Red Cross Swim Program and Lifesaving Society NL Program for Advanced Instruction.

To qualify, you must possess:

- Current Standard First Aid with CPR and Current Bronze Medallion and Cross
- Current National Lifeguard Service Pool Certification
- Current Water Safety Instructor Certification (for swimming instructors)
- Excellent communication, customer service and leadership skills
- Demonstrated teamwork abilities
- Previous experience with swim instruction and life guarding is an asset
- Complete a NB Student Employment Experience and Development (SEED) application

We are currently recruiting for 9 full time and 6 part time positions; the pay ranges for these positions is \$14.00 – \$15.00 per hour and are scheduled to begin as early as June and continue through until the end of August.

To ensure that we have all our staffing completed before the fast approaching summer, the deadline for applications is **February 24th, 2019**.
