Green Box

Containers

Plastic, Milk & Metal.

Plastic Containers

Rinse containers thoroughly. Remove caps. Look for the recycling symbol with 1, 2, or 5.



- Milk, juice jugs
- Yogurt containers, sour cream, cottage cheese tubs
- Ketchup, oil, vinegar & salad dressing bottles
- Shampoo bottles
- Bleach & detergent bottles
- Beverage containers (no glass)

Plastic Bags

Stuff bags into one bag.

- Shopping bags, bread bags, milk bags
- Bubble wrap

Milk Cartons

- Milk, cream & buttermilk cartons

Metal Containers

- All food & pet food cans
- Aluminum pie plates
- Clean aluminum foil
- Pop cans

DO NOT INCLUDE

- ✗ Styrofoam
- ✗ Black or coloured garbage bags
- ✗ Chip bags
- ✗ Aerosol & paint cans
- ✗ Glass

Blue Box

Paper & Cardboard

Clean and dry Paper & Cardboard.

Paper

- Newspaper
- Office paper & envelopes
- Catalogues, phone books
- Magazines, flyers, brochures & glossy paper
- Hard & soft cover books
- Shredded paper (in clear or paper bag)

Cardboard

- Packaging boxes
- Appliance boxes
- Cereal & cracker boxes
- Tissue boxes
- Egg cartons
- Toilet paper & paper towel cores

DO NOT INCLUDE

- ✗ Food contaminated paper or cardboard, e.g. pizza boxes
- ✗ Milk cartons
- ✗ Coffee cups
- ✗ Waxed cardboard
- ✗ Wax paper
- ✗ Gift wrap

Curbside is Coming!

Week of May 9th

Place your recycling boxes in a convenient location in your home. Sort your recycling into the two boxes, ready for curbside pick up on your regular compost collection day.

The **Blue box** is for your paper and cardboard.

The **Green box** is for your containers – plastic, milk & metal.

If you need additional recycling boxes they can be purchased at local hardware stores. Don't worry if it isn't a green-coloured box, just make sure you don't mix your containers and your papers together in the same box.

Oops – If you do make a mistake, you may discover an 'Oops' sticker on your box, and material may be left behind. It is important to make sure your containers and papers are separated into different boxes and consult the list for unacceptable items.

Tips:

Place items loose in the boxes. Do not bag items.

Except:

- Shredded paper which should be placed in a clear plastic bag, or paper bag and placed in the paper box.
- Plastic bags which should be stuffed into one plastic bag and placed in the containers box.

The lid can be used on either box. On windy or rainy days, please put the lid on the paper box and put the paper box on top of the other box.

Plastic containers and tins may be flattened to make more room.

Please flatten all boxes.

Corrugated cardboard should be flattened and placed under or between boxes, or tied in bundles no larger than 30" x 30" x 8" (76cm x 76cm x 20cm).
