BY-LAW NO. 034

A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE DAYS OF REST

The Council of the town of Quispamsis, under authority vested in it by Section 11(1) of the Municipalities Act of New Brunswick, enacts as follows:

1. TITLE

- a. This by-law may be cited as the Days of Rest By-law.

2. DEFINITIONS

- a. **“Council”** means the Council of the town of Quispamsis, a municipality in the county of Kings and the Province of New Brunswick;
- b. **“Retail Business”** means a retail business as defined in the Days of Rest Act of New Brunswick;
- c. **“Weekly Day of Rest”** means the weekly day of rest as defined in the Days of Rest Act of New Brunswick.

3. OPERATION OF A RETAIL BUSINESS

- a. Subject to Subsection 3(b), a Retail Business may open for business on the weekly day of rest.
- b. No person shall open, or cause to be open, a retail business within the boundaries of the Town of Quispamsis, on the following days:
 - i. New Years Day
 - ii. Good Friday
 - iii. Victoria Day
 - iv. Canada Day
 - v. New Brunswick Day
 - vi. Labour Day
 - vii. Thanksgiving Day
 - viii. Remembrance Day
 - ix. Christmas Day
 - x. Boxing Day

- c. The provisions of Subsection 3.(b) do not apply to any retail business exempted under the Days of Rest Act of New Brunswick and Regulations thereof.

4. PENALTY

- a. Any person who violates or fails to comply with any provision on this By-law is guilty of an offence and is liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not less than one hundred forty dollars (\$140.00) and not more than the maximum fine which may be imposed for commission of an offence punishable under PART II of the Provincial Offences Procedure Act as a Category D Offence.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE

- a. This by-law comes into effect on the date of final enactment thereof.
