TOWN OF QUISPAMISIS

BY-LAW NO. 55

A BY-LAW TO STOP UP & CLOSE

A PORTION OF THE HAMMOND RIVER ROAD

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of Quispamsis, pursuant to the authority of Section 187 of the Municipalities Act, R.S.N.B., 1979, the following portion of public highway be stopped up and closed:

All that certain piece or parcel of land comprising a portion of Hammond River Road, situate, lying and being in the Town of Quispamsis, Parish of Rothesay, County of Kings and Province of New Brunswick, and being adjacent to lands owned by the Rector, Church Wardens and Vestry of the Ecclesiastical Parish of Hammond River, the said portion being bounded and described as follows:

Beginning on the northeastern sideline of Hammond River Road at a point distant, seven (7.0) metres measured northwestwardly thereon from its intersection with the western sideline of N.B. Highway No. 1 (Mackay Highway), the said highway lying to the southeast of the herein described lands; going thence from the place of beginning on an azimuth referred to the north point of the New Brunswick Grid Co-Ordinate System, two hundred thirty-two (232) degrees, fifty-nine (59) minutes and zero-zero (00) seconds, two (2.0) metres; thence on an azimuth of three hundred twenty-two (322) degrees, fifty-nine minutes and zero-zero (00) seconds, sixteen (16.0) metres; thence on an azimuth of fifty-two (52) degrees, fifty-nine (59) minutes and zero-zero (00) seconds, two (2.0) metres to the aforesaid northeastern sideline of Hammond River Road; and thence on an azimuth of one hundred forty-two (142) degrees, fifty-nine (59) minutes and zero-zero (00) seconds, sixteen (16.0) metres to the place of beginning. The said parcel of land having an area of twenty-eight and eight tenths (28.8) square metres, as shown on the plan attached.
